



Closing Shelter Operations

SCHEDULE
☐ Determine when last meal is to be served.
☐ Schedule staff to handle closing activities.
CLEAN AND REPAIR
 Clean and disinfect, using appropriate disinfectant for the material and following manufacturer's instructions where applicable: Loaned/rented equipment All surfaces, furniture, and equipment within the area used during the shelter operation
☐ Return loaned equipment.
☐ Make repairs to restore all areas and equipment to pre-shelter condition.
☐ Clean blankets and cots as required.
☐ Vacuum carpets using a HEPA (high efficiency particulate air) filter so Norovirus and other viruses do not become airborne.
 For isolation areas including restrooms: Open outside doors and windows, if possible, and use ventilating fans to increase air circulation in the area. Wait 24 hours before cleaning and disinfecting with EPA-Registered Disinfectants for COVID-19.
INSPECT
☐ Inspect the dining area and kitchen to ensure that the areas are properly cleaned and sanitized and that all equipment is returned to its original location.
☐ Dispose of or donate excess supplies including food.
☐ Remove shelter signage inside and outside.
☐ Conduct a final inspection of the facility.
